



## **THE ROLE OF THE MUDCAT LEAGUE PARENT ASSISTANT COACH (PAC)**

1. Be available for all League games (or provide a qualified substitute) to assist the Koa head coach. The PAC will also read and understand the league rules.
2. Keep the book. Speed up the game in the following areas: help organize the offensive and defensive line ups, have the catcher geared up and/or provide a courtesy runner for the catcher with two outs, have players on deck and in the hole, monitor batting order
3. Wear Koa gear during all games (t-shirt, fleece, or hat) provide by Koa.
4. Assist Koa staff in making every Koa event a fun, positive, and learning atmosphere for the athletes.
5. Assist the Koa staff in keeping the players safe, including safety management in the dugout.
6. Notify Koa of any incidents within 24 hours.
7. Handle team equipment from Koa for the duration of the season, including initial pickup and end of the season drop off.
8. Read and sign the Koa Code of Conduct.
